Jaundice Is The Most Common Cause Of Readmission After Discharge From Birth Hospitalization. 1 Jaundice In Neonates Is Visible In Skin And Eyes When Total Serum Bilirubin (TSB) Concentration Exceeds 5 To 7 Mg/dL.
